STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section thirteen of chapter five hundred and thirty-two, private and special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-five, relating to the state college of agriculture and mechanic arts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter five hundred and thirty-two of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-five, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

Sect. 13. A reasonable charge shall be made for tuition, the amount of which shall be determined from time to time by the trustees; and the trustees and all persons employed by them, shall constantly endeavor, by the adoption of judicious and effective

10 arrangements in all the labor departments of the
11 college, to reduce the cost of subsistence to the
12 students, and to render the institution, as far as
13 possible, self-sustaining.
