STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section thirteen of chapter five hundred and thirty-two, private and special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-five, relating to the state college of agriculture and mechanic arts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter five hundred and thirty-

- 2 two of the private and special laws of eighteen
- 3 hundred and sixty-five, is hereby amended, so as
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Sect. 13. A reasonable charge shall be made for
- 6 tuition, the amount of which shall be determined
- 7 from time to time by the trustees; and the trustees
- 8 and all persons employed by them, shall constantly
- 9 endeavor, by the adoption of judicious and effective

- 10 arrangements in all the labor departments of the
- 11 college, to reduce the cost of subsistence to the
- 12 students, and to render the institution, as far as
- 13 possible, self-sustaining.
