STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT in relation to hawkers and pedlars.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any person receiving a license under the provis-2 ions of section two, chapter forty-four of the revised 3 statutes, shall, if he is not a resident of this state, 4 or if he is acting as agent, clerk or servant of any 5 person, who is not a resident of this state, or cor-6 poration not located in this state, pay for such 7 license, if he is to sell or offer to sell by retail, 8 twenty-five dollars; if by wholesale, fifty dollars. , .
