STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to lien claims.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. In all actions now pending, or that may 2 be hereafter brought to enforce a lien where the labor 3 or materials were not furnished by a contract with 4 the owner of the property to be affected, such 5 owner may voluntarily appear and become a party 6 to the suit. If he does not so appear, notice of the 7 suit, such as the court orders, shall be given him, 8 and he shall then become a party to the suit.

SECT. 2. In any such action, judgment may be 2 rendered for the plaintiff against the defendant, and 3 the property attached, covered by the lien, or 3 against either, for so much as shall be found due

4 by virtue of the lien; and in case the amount due
5 exceeds the amount covered by the lien, then a
6 separate execution shall be issued to the plaintiff
7 against the defendant for said excess, and the
8 plaintiff may discontinue as to any defendant. The
9 court may apportion costs as justice requires.
