## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to proceedings in court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That in all cases taken to the law court for argu-

- 2 ment and decision, all copies of the case, abstracts
- 3 containing the substance of all the material facts,
- 4 pleadings and documents on which the parties rely,
- 5 may be either printed or fairly and legibly written
- 6 on good paper.
