STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT regulating the duties of the clerks, registers and recording officers of the several counties in this state.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No clerk, register or recording officer of any 2 court in this state shall be attorney or counsellor 3 in any suit or matter pending in the court in which 4 he is such clerk, register or recording officer; 5 neither shall he commence actions to be entered in 6 his said court.
