STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT regulating the duties of the clerks, registers
and recording officers of the several counties in this
state.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-
sentatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

No clerk, register or recording officer of any
2 court in this state shall be attorney or counsellor
3 in any suit or matter pending in the court in which
4 he is such clerk, register or recording officer;
5 neither shall he commence actions to be entered in
6 his said court.
