STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-five of the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "an act to provide schools for the training of teachers in Madawaska territory."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of chapter eighty-five of the special 2 laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, is 3 hereby amended by striking out therefrom all in-4 cluded between the word "deduct," in the fourth 5 line, and the words "one thousand," in the eighth 6 line thereof, and inserting instead the words "from 7 any of the school moneys raised by the state for 8 the support of common schools, the sum of;" so 9 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

HOUSE-No. 135.

10 Sect. 2. To defray the expenses of said schools 11 the sum of eight hundred dollars is hereby appro-12 priated, in the manner hereinafter provided. The 13 treasurer of the state shall annually deduct from 14 any of the school moneys raised by the state for the 15 support of common schools, the sum of eight hun-16 dred dollars, which sum shall remain in the state 17 treasury, subject to the order of the governor and 18 council, for the payment of the expenses of said 19 schools, the title for which shall be approved by 20 the state superintendent of common schools, and 21 audited by the governor and council.
