## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT in relation to abatement of taxes in cities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The assessors of cities are hereby authorized and

- 2 empowered, and it shall be their duty to abate so
- 3 much of the taxes assessed on property in the
- 4 outskirts of cities which may be hereafter assessed
- 5 for the purposes of paying the expenses of police,
- 6 gas, sewerage and water, as will make the burdens
- 7 of taxation equal, according to the benefits; and
- 8 the right of appeal to the county commissioners
- 9 now provided for appeal on abatement of taxes
- 10 shall apply to the provisions of this act.
