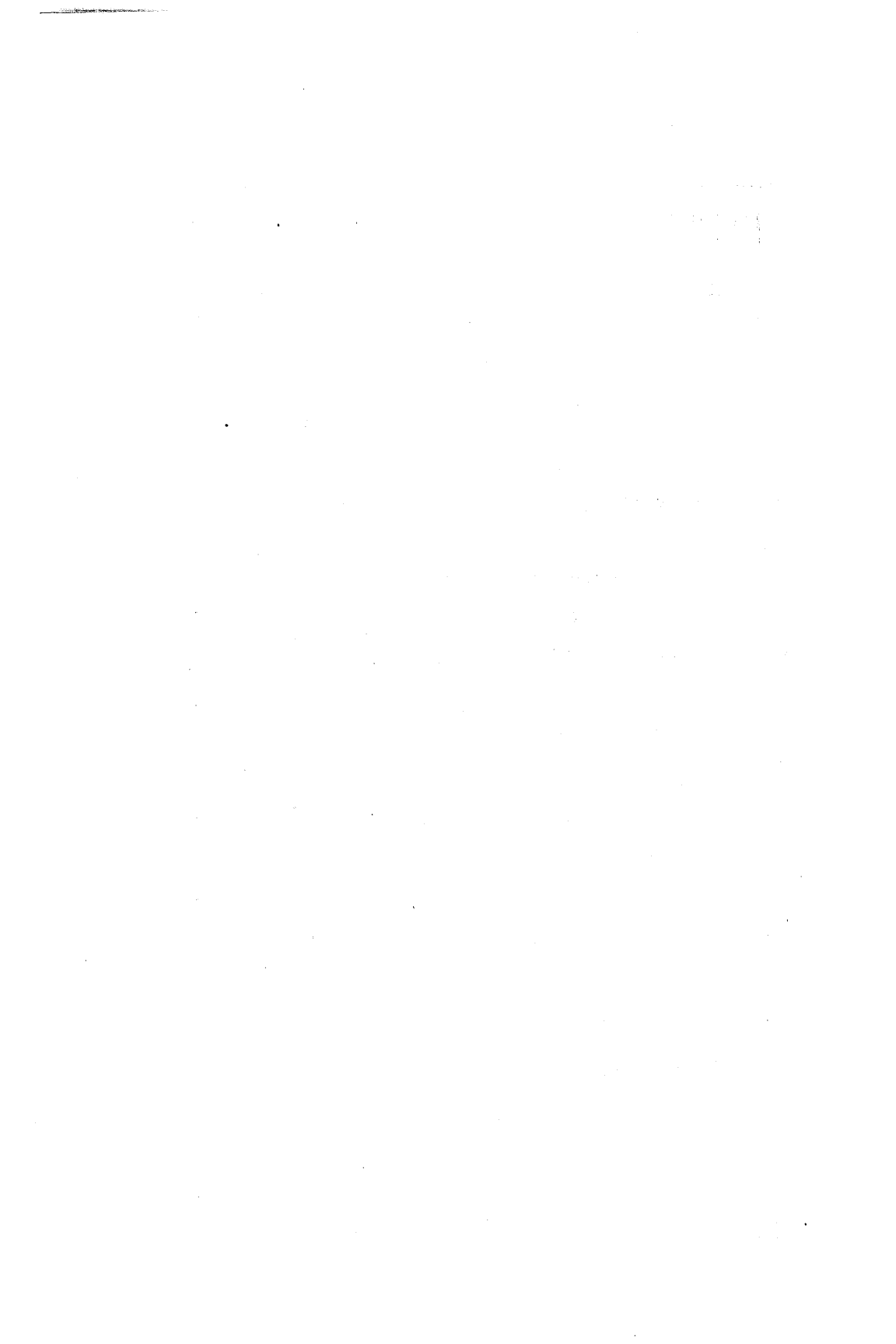
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section seventeen of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the revised statutes, in relation to fees of register of deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section seventeen of chapter one hundred and 2 sixteen of the revised statutes, is amended, by inserting after the word "records" in the fifth line 3 the following words: "and such indexes as heretofore made," so that the third, fourth, fifth and sixth 4 lines, shall read as follows:

7 For recording a levy, one dollar and fifty cents; 8 and the same sum for certified copies of these 9 instruments, as for recording them; and said registers shall make an alphabet to each volume of 10 records, and such indexes as heretofore made, 11 without charge to the county. 12
