STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section thirteen of chapter fortyone of the revised statutes, relating to the sale of coal.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter forty-one of the revised 2 statutes, is hereby amended, by striking out the 3 words "the parties otherwise agree, or" in the first 4 line, and inserting the words "on request of the 5 purchaser" after the word "shall" in the second 6 line, so that said section, as amended, shall read as 7 follows:

8 Sect. 13. Unless the coal is sold by the cargo, 9 the seller shall, on request of the purchaser, cause 10 the same to be weighed by a sworn weigher, who

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11 shall make a certificate of the weight thereof; and12 the seller shall not maintain a suit for the price of13 such coal, unless he had delivered such certificate14 to the buyer before its commencement.
