STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section thirteen of chapter forty-one of the revised statutes, relating to the sale of coal.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter forty-one of the revised
2 statutes, is hereby amended, by striking out the
3 words "the parties otherwise agree, or" in the first
4 line, and inserting the words "on request of the
5 purchaser" after the word "shall" in the second
6 line, so that said section, as amended, shall read as
7 follows:

8 *Sect. 13.* Unless the coal is sold by the cargo,
9 the seller shall, on request of the purchaser, cause
10 the same to be weighed by a sworn weigher, who

11 shall make a certificate of the weight thereof; and
12 the seller shall not maintain a suit for the price of
13 such coal, unless he had delivered such certificate
14 to the buyer before its commencement.
