AN ACT in relation to suits for taxes.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Hereafter no suit shall be commenced by any  
2 city, town or plantation, against any person for  
3 any taxes due, unless the same is directed in writ-  
4 ing by the selectmen of towns, the mayor and  
5 treasurer of cities, or the assessors of plantations.
