STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to bank issues and utilization
of coin in United States treasury.

Resolved, That the legislature of Maine, the Sen-
2 ate concurring, instruct our senators and request
3 representatives in congress to use their influence
4 and votes to procure the passage of the necessary
5 laws to carry into effect the following principles:

6 *First.* The abolition of all bank issues and the
7 unlimited coinage of gold and silver.

8 *Second.* The utilization of the coin in the
9 treasury in payment of the interest bearing debt.
