IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

[H. R. 2.] AN ACT to amend section second of chapter three hundred and ninety-six, approved March one, eighteen hundred and seventy, concerning the destruction of alewives in Dennys river.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section second of said act is hereby  
2 amended by striking out after the word "Dennys-  
3 ville," in the fifth line, the words "and between the  
4 hours of sunset on Thursday and sunset on Satur-  
5 day of each week, in that portion of the river be-  
6 tween said fishway and the town of Meddybemps."  
7 Also, insert after the word "week," in the ninth  
8 line, the words "below the stone bridge," so that  
9 said section as amended shall read as follows:

10 *Sect. 2.* The use of any means or implements for  
11 the taking or destroying of alewives, or obstructing  
12 their passage in said river, except between the hours  
13 of sunrise on Monday and sunset on the following  
14 Thursday of each week, in all that portion of the  
15 river below the fishway at Lincoln's mills in the  
16 town of Dennysville; and between the hours of  
17 sunset on Monday and sunset on the following  
18 Friday of each week, below the stone bridge in  
19 the town of Meddybemps, from the first day of  
20 January till the first day of August, every year, is  
21 hereby prohibited.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
