STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

[S. 21.] AN ACT to amend chapter fourteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-two in relation to service of precepts upon deputy sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter fourteen of the public laws 2 of eighteen hundred and seventy-two is hereby 3 amended so as to read as follows:

4 Any writ or precept in which the deputy of a 5 sheriff is a party may be served by any other 6 deputy of the same sheriff.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
