
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

[S. 23.] AN ACT to exempt the Lewiston and Auburn railroad from taxation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The Lewiston and Auburn railroad
- 2 company is hereby exempted from the provisions
- 3 of chapter two hundred and fifty-eight of the
- 4 public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four,
- 5 entitled "an act relating to the taxation of railroad
- 6 corporations," approved March fourth, eighteen
- 7 hundred and seventy-four, so long as the stock of
- 8 said railroad is owned wholly by the cities of Lew-
- 9 iston and Auburn.
 - Sect. 2. All taxes assessed by the state and now
- 2 standing against said railroad are hereby abated.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
