STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT relating to scire facias.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whenever it shall hereafter appear in any suit of
2 scire facias on a recognizance taken in a criminal
3 case, that the surety has surrendered the principal
4 into court for sentence, and the principal has been
5 actually sentenced upon the indictment or com-
6 plaint on which the recognizance was taken, such
7 suit shall be dismissed upon the payment of the
8 costs therein.
