STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the erection of dams and booms in the Androscoggin river at Canton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Charles H. Gilbert and Zimri E. Gil-

- 2 bert, their associates, successors and assigns, are
- 3 hereby authorized and empowered to locate, build
- 4 and maintain in the Androscoggin river at Canton,
- 5 in the county of Oxford, dams, piers and booms
- 6 for the purpose of booming and holding logs,
- 7 spars, and other lumber. But the said works shall
- 8 be so constructed as to provide for prompt and
- 9 convenient passage of all logs, spars and other
- 10 lumber that may come within the same, without
- 11 unreasonable or unnecessary obstruction or delay,

12 in no case exceeding a delay of forty-eight hours 13 at one time.

SECT. 2. Said parties may be and hold all logs, 2 spars or other lumber which may come within said 3 booms, whenever the owners thereof shall request 4 them in writing to do so, which requests shall be 5 filed with the agent of the booms at Canton, and 6 be there preserved for the examination at all times 7 of any person interested; and they may therefor 8 demand, collect and receive a toll of fifty cents for 9 each and every thousand feet so boomed and held. Sect. 3. The parties named in the first section 2 of this act, their associates, successors and assigns, 3 may take such lands as may be necessary for the '4 erection and maintenance of said dams and booms, 5 and for connecting the same with the shores, and 6 may with their agents and teams pass and repass 7 over said shores, and to and from them, over the 8 lands of other persons, for the purposes aforesaid, 9 and for managing said booms, making compensa-10 tion therefor as is provided in the case of damages

11 for lands taken in laying out highways.
