STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to facilitate the settlement of the publiclands, and closing the land office.

Resolved, That the land agent be and he hereby 2 is authorized to convey by deed to all persons who 3 now or hereafter may legally hold certificates of 4 land from the state, either directly or by assign-5 ment, the land described in such certificates, upon 6 such persons furnishing satisfactory proof before 7 the first day of January, A. D. eighteen hundred 8 and eighty, that they are the sole owners of said 9 certificates, that no other person has any legal or 10 equitable interest in the land therein described, and 11 that all road labor due in payment of said land has 12 been performed, all other settling duties being 13 hereby waved. The price of said land shall be 14 thirty-five cents per acre, payable in road labor;

15 provided, that nothing herein contained shall 16 authorize any person to make any claim against 17 the state for any excess of road labor over and 18 above thirty-five cents per acre, performed in pay-19 ment of any land.
