STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for distribution of stationery
to members of the legislature.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be directed
2 to furnish hereafter, each member of the legislature,
3 two boxes of stationery each year, and no more,
4 such as has been furnished the present year, and
5 they shall receive no other perquisite. The secre-
6 tary of state is hereby directed to keep a detailed
7 account of all stationery delivered to each depart-
8 ment, and is forbidden to deliver to any other
9 person; *provided,* that this resolve shall not pro-
10 hibit the usual amount of blanks to members, and
11 stationery for committees of the legislature, and
12 for the use of the clerk of the house and secretary
13 of the senate.
