## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE confirming the location of lots reserved  
for public uses in the town of Blaine.

---

*Resolved,* That the location and designation of  
2 lots numbered twenty-three, twenty-four, thirty-six,  
3 and the north half of lot numbered thirty-seven, in  
4 the town of Blaine, according to the survey and  
5 plan of said town made by Parker P. Burleigh in  
6 the year eighteen hundred and fifty-six, and set  
7 apart in the land office as the lots reserved for  
8 public uses in said town, is hereby confirmed;  
9 and the board of ministerial and school funds in  
10 said town is hereby authorized to maintain any  
11 suit in their own name or in the name of the state  
12 to recover claims for trespass, stumpage or other-  
13 wise, now existing against said lots.
