IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-four of the revised statutes, relating to auctions and auctioneers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter thirty-four of the revised statutes is 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following 3 section:

- 4 Sect. 10. The municipal officers of any city or
- 5 town in this state, may grant upon presentation of
- 6 an invoice or inventory of the property to be sold,
- 7 a special license to any auctioneer, a legal voter in
- 8 this state, to sell at public auction, between the
- 9 hours of 7Λ . M. and 6 P. M., upon the payment

10 of five dollars for each and every invoice or inven-11 tory, the above license fee to go to the use of said12 city or town.
