RESOLVE in favor of the town of Mayfield.

---

*Resolved,* That three hundred dollars be appropriated to assist the town of Mayfield in building a road leading from Brighton Center to Kingsbury Mills, through said town of Mayfield, the same to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Somerset county; *provided,* that said town of Mayfield shall raise and expend an equal sum on said road.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

As found before the Committee, on petition of Virgil P. Hall and others :

Three hundred dollars were appropriated by the Legislature last winter to build this road. Those interested in this road, desiring a small change in its location, petitioned to the County Commissioners to make the change desired. The Commissioners did not report in season to enable the town to expend the money appropriated, hence it reverted to the State. There is a population of about 100 in this town, and a valuation of \$20,000, debt \$900.
