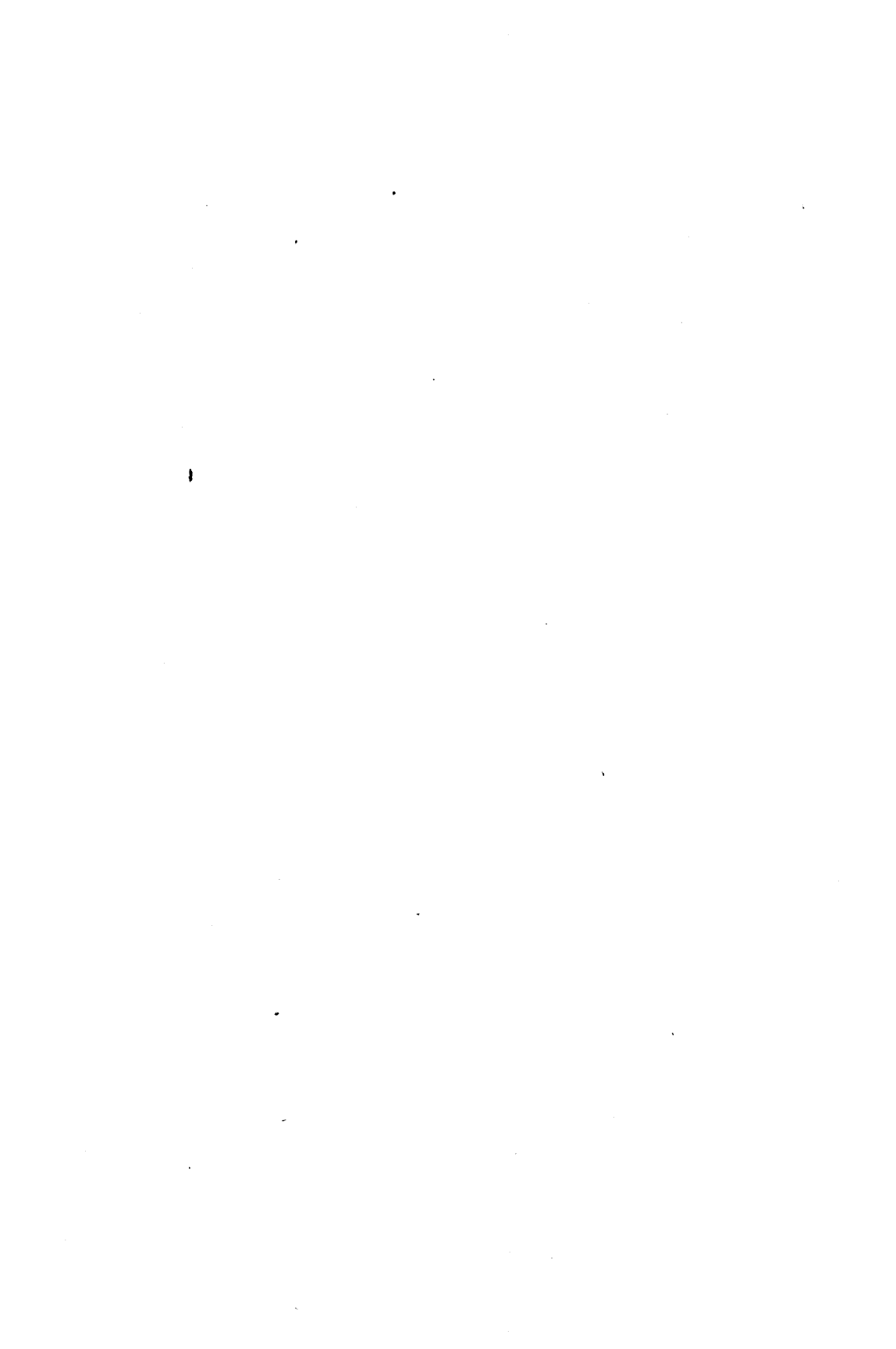

### AN ACT to regulate the taking and shooting of pigeons.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Whoever wilfully commits any trespass by killing  
2 pigeons on or frightening them from beds made  
3 for the purpose of taking them in nets, by firing  
4 guns or in any other manner, within one hundred  
5 rods of the same, except on lands lawfully occupied  
6 by himself, shall be punished by imprisonment in  
7 the jail not exceeding thirty days, or by fine not  
8 exceeding twenty dollars; and shall also be liable  
9 for the actual damages to the owner or occupant  
10 of such beds.
