## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to regulate the terms for jury trials in the superior court for the county of Cumberland, and to transfer the criminal jurisdiction of said court to the supreme judicial court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section six of chapter one hundred

- 2 and fifty-one of the public laws of the year eigh-
- 3 teen hundred and sixty-eight is hereby amended in
- 4 the second clause of said section by striking out
- 5 the words "at said terms," and inserting instead
- 6 thereof the words "at the September, December,
- 7 March and May terms of said court," and by strik-
- 8 ing out the words "except that the same jurors may
- 9 be required by the justice to serve for two suc-

- 10 cessive terms;" so that said second clause in said
- 11 sixth section as amended shall read as follows:
- 12 Traverse jurors shall be drawn and returned to
- 13 serve at the September, December, March and May
- 14 terms of said court as in the supreme judicial
- 15 court.
  - Sect. 2. The original and appellate criminal juris-
  - 2 diction now vested in and exercised by said supe-
  - 3 rior court for the county of Cumberland, and all
  - 4 powers incident thereto, after the next May term of
  - 5 said superior court shall be transferred to and con-
  - 6 ferred upon the supreme judicial court for said
  - 7 county of Cumberland, which court shall there-
  - 8 after exercise the same in the same manner as was
- 9 authorized by law to be exercised by said supreme
- 10 judicial court before the act approved March sixth
- 11 eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act
- 12 to enlarge the jurisdiction of the superior court in
- 13 the county of Cumberland," went into effect.
  - Sect. 3. Said criminal business of said county of
  - 2 Cumberland, shall, after the next May term thereof.
  - 3 be transacted at the terms of said supreme judicial
  - 4 court held within and for said county of Cumber-
  - 5 land on the second Tuesdays of April, October,
  - 6 and January, together with the civil business of
  - 7 said court.

All indictments and informations and 2 all criminal processes pending in said superior court 3 for said county at the adjournment of the next May 4 term thereof, shall be transferred to said supreme 5 judicial court for said county, and shall be entered 6 upon the docket at the next October term thereof, 7 and shall have day therein, and all warrants and 8 recognizances, appeals in criminal cases, and all 9 criminal processes whatever, which but for the 10 passage of this act would be returnable to or which 11 by law would be entered in said superior court in 12 said county on the first Tuesday of September, 13 eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, shall be re-14 turnable to and entered upon the docket of said .15 supreme judicial court at said October term thereof, 16 and shall have day therein. And all parties, all 17 grand and traverse jurors, witnesses, and others 18 who would but for the passage of this act be held 19 to appear at said superior court for said county on 20 the first Tuesday of September, eighteen hundred 21 and seventy-nine, shall be held to appear at said 22 October term of said supreme judicial court for said 23 county. Venires for grand jurors to serve at said 24 supreme judicial court for said county shall be 25 issued at least forty days before the second Tuesday 26 of October, annually, and such jurors shall serve

- 27 at every term of said supreme judicial court for 28 said county for the transaction of criminal business 29 throughout the year.
- Sect. 5. When both parties to any action pend2 ing in said superior court consent, the justice of
  3 said superior court may certify said action to the
  4 supreme judicial court for said county, and there5 upon all the papers relating thereto shall be forth6 with transferred to said supreme judicial court, and
  7 said action shall be entered upon the docket of said
  8 supreme judicial court, and shall have day therein,
  9 and shall be disposed of in the same manner as
  10 though it had been originally commenced in said
  - SECT. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
