STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Alfred Veazie.

Resolved, That the sum of eighty dollars and
2 interest on the same from November twenty-fifth,
3 eighteen hundred sixty-seven, be paid to Alfred
4 Veazie, being for money paid said Veazie for lot
5 reserved for the future disposition of the legisla-
6 ture, in township E, Franklin county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The lot which was purchased by said Alfred Veazie, and for which he paid the State eighty dollars on the 25th day of November, 1867, had been conveyed by the State of Massachusetts to James McLellan, on the third day of September, 1823, as is shown by Schedules of Lands, page 51, conveyed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, now in the Land Office.
