STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter sixty-
seven of revised statutes, relating to guardians of
minors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section one of chapter sixty-seven (67) of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended, by adding to said sec-
3 tion the following words, "unless he be the parent
4 of such minor," so that said section as amended
5 shall read as follows:

6 *Sect. 1.* The judge of probate may appoint guar-
7 dians to minors residing in his county, or out of the
8 state and having estate in his county; but no ex-
9 executor or administrator on an estate shall be
10 guardian to a minor interested therein, unless he be
11 parent of such minor.
