STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Eugene Michaud.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state
2 treasury, to Eugene Michaud, (called Zebulon
3 Michaud) the sum of forty-nine dollars and thirty-
4 six cents, being for money paid by him July eleven,
5 eighteen hundred and forty-nine, for lot numbered
6 forty-four in township numbered seventeen, range
7 seven, Aroostook county, said lot having been
8 awarded to said Michaud under the treaty of
9 Washington.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the year 1849 Zebulon, called Eugene, Michaud, paid the State for lot 44 in cash, and the same lot was awarded to the said Michaud under the Treaty of Washington, and the State received from the United States the cash for the same lot, at the rate of \$1.25 per acre. The cash was paid to the State July 11, 1849, at fifty cents per acre.
