STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to establish the salaries of certain public
officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The salary of the land agent shall
2 be eight hundred dollars per annum, to be paid in
3 quarterly payments from the treasury of the state.

SECT. 2. The clerk hire for the superintendent of
2 schools shall not exceed five hundred dollars per
3 annum.

SECT. 3. The salary of the messenger to the
2 governor and council, shall be five hundred dollars
3 per annum, in full for all services and travel.

SECT. 4. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent

2 with the provisions of this act, are hereby re-
3 pealed.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its approval by the governor.
