STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit the payment of any money from the treasury of the state for agricultural purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No money shall be drawn or paid
2 out from the treasury of the state, for the printing
3 of agricultural reports or documents, or for any
4 purpose connected with agricultural societies, or
5 for the board of agriculture, or for compensation
6 of any officer connected therewith.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved
2 by the governor.
