STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-NINE.

AN ACT to abolish the office of inspectors of state
prison and jails.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The office of inspectors of state
2 prison and jails is hereby abolished.

SECT. 2. All acts inconsistent with this act are
2 repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved
2 by the governor.
