STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the appointment of a commission to investigate the manner of taking porgies on the coast of Maine, and its effect upon shore fisheries.

Resolved, That the governor be instructed to ap-
2 point a commission consisting of three persons,
3 whose duty it shall be to fully investigate the man-
4 ner of taking porgies on the coast of Maine, and
5 its effect upon the shore fisheries of the state, and
6 report the same to the next legislature. Said com-
7 mission to serve without compensation for time or
8 expense.
