STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend section sixteen, chapter four of the revised statutes, relating to the removal of electors from one ward to another.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section sixteen of chapter four of

- 2 the revised statutes, is hereby amended by strik-
- 3 ing out the word "thirty" in the sixth line of said
- 4 section, and inserting in place thereof the word
- 5 "sixty," so that said section as amended shall read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 Sect. 16. In all cities having more than one
- 8 thousand legal voters therein, it shall be the duty
- 9 of the aldermen thereof to post up in some public
- 10 place in each ward, a true printed or written list

- 11 of the legal voters resident in said ward, at least
- 12 seven days previous to the day of any election.
- 13 No qualified elector who has removed his residence
- 14 from one ward to another in any city, within the
- 15 sixty days next preceding any election, shall vote
- 16 at such election in the ward to which he has re-
- 17 moved, but his name may be placed on the check
- 18 list of the ward from which he has removed, and
- 19 he may vote therein.
 - Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent 2 with the foregoing provisions are hereby repealed.

 Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
