## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Levant.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of

- 2 state, out of the school funds for the current year, to the town of Levant, the sum of thirty-five dol-
- 4 lars and fifteen cents, it being a balance in equity
- 5 due said town as its proportion of the school funds
- 6 for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in legislature assembled:

Respectfully represents the undersigned, selectmen and superintending school committee of the town of Levant, in Penobscot
county, that in the return of scholars to the office of the State
Superintendent of Schools in the year 1878, an omission of twentytwo scholars, between the ages of four and twenty-one years, as
the census taken at that time will show, therefore the apportionment was made for 416 scholars, when in truth and in fact it
should have been 438. We therefore respectfully ask that a resolution may be passed by your honorable body directing the treasurer of State to pay to said town of Levant the sum of thirty-five
dollars and fifteen cents, being the amount equitably due said town
for the year 1878, by the reason of the omission to return the
twenty-two scholars as above mentioned.
