RESOLVE in favor of the Houlton and Baring road across Indian Township and Grand Lake Stream road in Washington county.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars

- 4 Indian township, also that the sum of two hundred
- 5 dollars be appropriated to be expended on the road
- 6 leading from the Houlton and Baring road in said
- 7 Indian township to Grand Lake stream, said sums
- 8 to be expended under the direction of the governor
- 9 and council.
