STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirteen
of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine,
relating to auctioneers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Chapter one hundred and thirteen of the public
2 laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine is
3 hereby amended, by adding, after the word "sold"
4 in the third line of section ten, the words "which
5 shall be produced unless said municipal officers
6 shall decide that the same is unnecessary, in which
7 case they may grant a license upon written appli-
8 cation therefor," so that when amended the same
9 shall read:

10 *Sect. 10.* The municipal officers of any city or
11 town in this state may grant upon presentation of

12 an invoice or inventory of the property to be sold,
13 which shall be produced unless said municipal offi-
14 cers shall decide that the same is unnecessary, in
15 which case they may grant a license upon written
16 application therefor, a special license to any auction-
17 eer, a legal voter in this state, to sell at public auc-
18 tion, between the hours of seven A.M. and six P.M.,
19 upon the payment of five dollars for each and every
20 invoice or inventory, the above license fee to go to
21 the use of said city or town.
