AN ACT to protect ducks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

No duck or ducks shall at any time be shot at
2 from any vessel or boat, while under sail or pro-
3 pelled by steam, under penalty of twenty-five dol-
4 lars for such offence, and there shall be a lien upon
5 any vessel or boat wherein such offence is com-
6 mitted, to the amount of all penalties and costs
7 incurred, to be enforced by attachment.
