IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to protect ducks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No duck or ducks shall at any time be shot at

- 2 from any vessel or boat, while under sail or pro-
- 3 pelled by steam, under penalty of twenty-five dol-
- 4 lars for such offence, and there shall be a lien upon
- 5 any vessel or boat wherein such offence is com-
- 6 mitted, to the amount of all penalties and costs
- 7 incurred, to be enforced by attachment.
