STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to protect quails.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

No quail shall be killed, nor had in possession except alive, at any time previous to September first, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, under penalty of twenty-five dollars for every offence and one dollar additional for each quail killed or had in possession except alive.
