

### STATE OF MAINE.

#### RESOLVE in favor of town of Exeter.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of 2 state to the town of Exeter, the amount of tax now 3 in said treasury and justly due said town of Exeter, 4 paid into the treasury by the Maine central railroad 5 on three hundred and thirty-one shares of said rail-6 road stock, owned by Sarah A. Hill of said Exeter, 7 said Sarah A. Hill's residence being erroneously 8 given on said railroad returns as Canada. The 9 amount equitably due said Exeter being three hun-10 dred seventy-eight dollars and thirty-eight cents, 11 (\$378.38).
