IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT in relation to defences in actions involving
contracts made on Sunday.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

No person who receives any money, or valuable
2 thing as the consideration for a contract, express
3 or implied, made and entered into on Sunday, shall
4 be permitted to defend any action upon such con-
5 tract on the ground that it was so made and en-
6 tered into on Sunday, until he shall restore such
7 consideration, so received.
