STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT in relation to service on domestic corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. When no officer, general agent, or

2 member of a domestic corporation, can be found in

3 the county in which the same is located, nor in the

4 county in which its last certificate of election of

5 clerk has been filed, the officer having in his hands

6 any process for service on such corporation, may

7 file a copy thereof in the registry of deeds of the

8 county in which such corporation was located, or

9 in which the last certificate of election of clerk was

10 filed, and make return of his doings, which service

- 11 shall be sufficient to hold said corporation to 12 answer to such process.
 - SECT. 2. The register of deeds shall keep such 2 copy on file, and keep an index thereof, and be 3 entitled to a fee of twenty cents therefor, to be 4 paid by the office.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
