STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to provide for the registry of deeds from
the state.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. A copy from the records now in the
2 land office of a deed from the state, of the land of
3 the state, or of a deed from the state and the com-
4 monwealth of Massachusetts, of the undivided
5 lands of the state and said commonwealth, certi-
6 fied by the land agent and approved by the gover-
7 nor, or certified by the secretary of state and
8 approved by the governor, as a true copy of such
9 record, may be filed and recorded in the registry of
10 deeds in the county where the land lies, and shall
11 have the same effect as if the deed itself had been

12 recorded, and certified copies thereof from such
13 registry shall be evidence when the original would
14 be.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
