STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fifteen,
section six, of the revised statutes, relating to the
compensation of members of the government.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section six of chapter one hundred and fifteen of
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking
3 out the words "two dollars," in the second and sixth
4 lines, and inserting instead thereof the words 'one
5 dollar,' so that said section as amended shall read
6 as follows:

7 *Sect. 6.* Each member of the council shall be
8 paid two dollars for every day's attendance, and one
9 dollar for every ten miles travel from his place of
10 abode at each session. Each member of the senate

11 and house of representatives shall be paid a salary
12 of one hundred and fifty dollars for the regular an-
13 nual session of the legislature, and one dollar for
14 every ten miles' travel from his place of abode, once
15 in each session. He is entitled to mileage on the
16 first day of the session, and fifty dollars of his sal-
17 ary on the first day of each month thereafter during
18 the session, and the balance at the end thereof; but
19 two dollars shall be deducted from the pay of every
20 member for each day that he is absent from his
21 duties without being excused by the house to which
22 he belongs. The president of the senate and
23 speaker of the house of representatives shall be
24 paid a salary of three hundred dollars for each ses-
25 sion, with the same mileage as other members, and
26 subject to the same deduction in case of absence.
27 Any member acting as president pro tem. of the
28 senate, or speaker pro tem. of the house, shall re-
29 ceive two dollars per day extra therefor. When an
30 extra session is called by the governor, the mem-
31 bers of the senate and house of representatives
32 shall each be paid two dollars for every day's at-
33 tendance, and mileage as aforesaid. The president
34 of the senate and speaker of the house of represen-
35 tatives at such extra session shall receive in addi-
36 tion two dollars for every day's attendance. The

COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS.

ART. 3

37 secretary of the senate and clerk of the house of
38 representatives shall be paid three dollars each, and
39 their assistants two dollars each, for every day of
40 their employment. The treasurer of state shall
41 make pay rolls and payments according to these
42 provisions.
