STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fourteen of the revised statutes, relating to new trials for capital offences.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter one hundred and fourteen of the public 2 laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six is hereby 3 amended, by adding the following section thereto: 4 Sect. 9. The supreme judicial court, or any 5 superior court, before which any person has been or 6 may be convicted for a capital offence, may either 7 in term time or vacation, when on the petition or 8 motion in writing of such person, it is made to 9 appear to the court that justice may be better done 10 thereby, grant a new trial for any cause for which 11 a new trial may or should be granted.
