STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to prevent the taking of land-locked salmon
in certain lakes in the county of Aroostook.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. All persons are forbidden to take
2 land-locked salmon in the following named lakes
3 in the county of Aroostook: New Limerick lake,
4 commonly known as Nickerson lake, situate on lots
5 one, two, three and four, range F, in New Limerick,
6 and on lots A, range one, and A, range four, in
7 Linneus; Deep lake, situate on lots four and five,
8 range nine; south division of Littleton and Madi-
9 gan lake, situate on lots one and ten, range eight,
10 in the north division of Littleton, for the term of
11 five years from the passage of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of
2 this act shall be punished by fine not exceeding ten
3 dollars for each land-locked salmon so taken, to be
4 recovered on complaint before any trial justice in
5 said county, one-half to the use of the complain-
6 ant and the other half to the use of the town
7 wherein said complainant resides.
