STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT giving Justices of the Peace and of the
Quorum jurisdiction throughout the state.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Justices of the peace and of the quorum shall be
2 appointed and commissioned by the governor, with
3 the advice and consent of the council, to act within
4 and for each and every county throughout the state.
5 All duties and powers now granted by law to and
6 exercised by justices of the peace and of the
7 quorum, shall be exercised by them in each and
8 every county in the state.
