STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

AN ACT to amend section thirteen of chapter one hundred forty-one of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter one hundred and 2 forty-one of the revised statutes is hereby amended 3 by adding at the end thereof the words, "*Provided*, 4 *however*, that the charge for board of any such 5 prisoner shall not exceed two dollars per week," 6 so that said section as amended shall read as follows: 7 *Sect.* 13. When a sum of money is due the 8 master under the provisions of this chapter from 9 any prisoner, and his account is duly allowed and 10 certified to be correct by the commissioners, he may 11 demand it of the prisoner, if of age, otherwise of

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12 his parent, master or guardian; and if the party 13 liable is not able to pay, he may demand it of the 14 overseers of the town where such prisoner has his 15 legal settlement. *Provided, however*, that the 16 charge for board of any such prisoner shall not 17 exceed two dollars per week.
