IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

AN ACT concerning the acknowledgment of deeds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The acknowledgment of deeds may
2 be made before any notary public in this state.

SECT. 2. All acknowledgment of deeds hereto-
2 fore made in this state before a notary public duly
3 commissioned and qualified, shall be deemed and
4 taken to be legal and valid.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
